Full Council meeting

Full Council met and in addition to the usual admin stuff for the start of a new council there was one significant item viz Location of New Council Headquarters. Council voted to move to Alconbury Weald. As far as I'm concerned this was a bad decision, it has been taken too soon and it's based on too much flaky data. Committee meetings and other council matters

<u>Adults</u>: there were no key decisions. Elsewhere on the agenda it approved the Cambridgeshire & Peterborough (C&P) dementia strategic plan

Children & Young People: there were no key decisions

<u>General Purpose</u>: there were three key decisions. In the first it agreed to fund the Ely Southern Bypass funding shortfall. This is a bit of a scandal because councillors pressured officers to accelerate the program at risk and with no contingency. Go to <u>wp.me/p7tuu7-1Nr</u> and <u>wp.me/p7tuu7-1Oj</u> for my take. The other two related to the re-procurement of the Cambridgeshire Public Service Network and spending an extra £2.74 million on the Children's Services IT system

<u>Health</u>: there were no key decisions. In its scrutiny role it met the Cambridgeshire & Peterborough Clinical Commissioning Group to review its progress in closing its budget gap. It's not easy!

<u>Highways & Community Infrastructure:</u> this committee did not meet. That's the second month in a row that the committee responsible for the maintenance of our roads has not met.

<u>Commercial & Investment</u>: there were no key decisions. Thankfully the committee did not go into private session but sadly voted for handing over assets to This Land without democratic oversight.

<u>Environment & Economy</u>: there were two key decisions viz re-procuring the Cambridgeshire Archaeological Services and endorsing the Wisbech access strategy (which includes a rail connection)

<u>Communities & Partnerships:</u> there were no key decisions. Note that there is now no Area Champion for South Cambs which means that individual councillors will once again have to fill this role.

<u>Planning</u>: this committee approved the Histon Junior School expansion. For full details go to https://bit.ly/2sAM183. The approval includes multiple conditions including the one relating to improvements to the pavement on the east side of Station Road.

Health & Well Being Board: the Board met and reviewed the C&P dementia strategic plan (as above).

The <u>Cambridgeshire & Peterborough Combined Authority</u> (CA) met and is beginning to flex its muscles. It's clear that the Mayor and the CA would like to subsume the Greater Cambridge Partnership (GCP) much as they did the Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP). In this meeting it laid out its 4 year plan which encompasses several ambitious transport schemes (including the CAM metro and, worryingly, and extension of the M11 northwards to Wisbech) and began to consider the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Independent Economic Review (CPIER).

Neither the <u>Greater Cambridge Partnership Assembly</u> nor the <u>Greater Cambridge Partnership</u> Executive Board met.

I met the H&I older people's co-ordinator to review options for the delivery of a program involving IVC students to support older people in their IT use.

I 'chaired' two meetings of the A14 core group. There is progress with respect to engagement with Highways England and the A14 Delivery Group and with South Cambs but there's still a way to go.
